

Use of Images of Children/Young People under the Age of 18

Ten Golden Rules

to Remember

1. All children featured in recordings must be appropriately dressed with outer clothing garments covering their torso from at least the bottom of their neck to their thighs, (i.e. a minimum of a vest/shirt and shorts).
2. Photography or recording will focus on the activity or team, not a particular young person.
3. Images should focus on small groups rather than individuals.
4. Children's names (first name or surname) will not be used in photograph captions.
5. Images of a child under court order will not be used.
6. Personal details will never be revealed.
7. We endeavour to use photographs that represent a broad range of youngsters that participate in sport.
8. All people taking photographs or recording footage at an event should register with Jikan Dojo.
9. Any instances of the use of inappropriate images will be reported to the NSPCC Helpline or the Internet Watch Foundation (IWF).
10. We do not allow unsupervised access to Jikan Dojo members and do not approve or allow photo sessions outside the event or at a Jikan Dojo member's home.
